Eurasian Hobby Falco subbuteo

One shot at Bird Island in November 1936, while eating a Fairy Tern *Gygis alba* (Vesey-Fitzgerald, collector). This is the 28th record for Seychelles but chronologically it is the 1st record.

Western Honey Buzzard Pernis sp.

One adult at Denis Island 22 November to about 29 November 2010 (RM Mason); accepted with a caveat that Oriental Honey Buzzard could not be ruled out. This is the 5th record for Seychelles (and the 2nd for Denis).






Black-naped Tern Sterna sumatrana

One possibly immature at North Point, Bird Island on 25 March 2011 (CJ Feare). This the 6th record east of the Amirantes (and the 2nd for Bird).


Common Swift Apus apus

One at the east coast, St François on 11 January 2011 (A Nahaboo, A Duhec, R Jeanne, J Michel). This is the 23rd record for Seychelles (and the 2nd for St François). It is also the first January record.



European Roller Coracias garrulus

One immature found dead at Denis Island in March 2011 (RM Mason, CJ Feare). This is the 44th record for Seychelles (and the 3rd for Denis).



Yellow Wagtail Motacilla flava

One adult male, probably race *beema*, behind the staff canteen, Alphonse 10-14 January 2011 (D Louis, A Nahaboo, A Duhec). This is the 46th record for Seychelles (and the 4th for Alphonse).




