#### The following records were accepted during October 2012:

# Squacco Heron Ardeola ralloides or Indian Pond Heron A. grayii

Two near the airstrip, Assumption on 16 February 2012 (CJ Feare).

This is the first record in this category. There have been 5 accepted records of Squacco Heron and 7 of Indian Pond Heron.

# Madagascar Pond Heron Ardeola idae

One immature at the centre of south Assumption on 4 March 2012 and possibly the same individual at the settlement 13-17 March 2012 (CJ Feare).


This is the 6<sup>th</sup> record at an island other than Aldabra, where this species breeds.

# Purple Heron Ardea purpurea

One juvenile at the western beach, Assumption on 2 November 2012 (CJ Feare). This is the first record west of the Amirantes, where it is an annual visitor.

### Great Egret Egretta alba

One adult at Middle Camp, Malabar, Aldabra on 27 January 2012 (M Šúr). This is the 18<sup>th</sup> record for Seychelles. *Photo: Michal Šúr* 





#### Northern Shoveler Anas clypeata

One female at Denis Island on 23 November 2011 (M Unrath, J Chang Tave). His is the 10<sup>th</sup> record for Seychelles.





### Eleonora's Falcon Falco eleonorae or Sooty Falcon F. concolor

One above the settlement, Assumption on 8 December 2011 (C Onezia, CJ Feare).

This is the 2<sup>nd</sup> record in this category. There have been 33 records of Eleonora's Falcon and 5 of Sooty Falcon.

# **Black Kite** *Milvus migrans*

One adult at the Settlement, Picard, Aldabra 12-15 February 2012 (A Gouffe, S Denis, M Green, C Onezia, M van Dinther and J van de Crommenacker).

This is the 4<sup>th</sup> record for Seychelles.



One at the airstrip and canteen area, Alphonse 18-20 January 2012 (A Duhec, R Jeanne)

This is the 7<sup>th</sup> record for Seychelles.

# Greater Crested Tern Sterna bergii velox

One adult at One Palm Island, St Francois on 15 February 2012 (R Jeanne, A Duhec)

This is the 3<sup>rd</sup> record for Seychelles of this race.

# Namaqua Dove Oena capensis

One sub-adult female near the settlement, Assumption 16-17 January 2012 (CJ Feare, J Linnebjerg, I Labrosse, T Mahoune, P Benoit). This is the 2<sup>nd</sup> record for Seychelles.

# Comoro Blue Pigeon Alectroenas sganzini

One immature at the north of the airstrip, Assumption 18-22 March 2012 (CJ Feare). This is the first record outside Aldabra for more than a century. The secies probably bred throughout the Aldabra Group prior to the arrival of man and possibly also in the Farquhar Group.

#### Common Cuckoo Cuculus canorus

One adult female at Anse Grand Police, Mahe on 18 November 2011 (U Samedi). One at the Helipad, Aride on 26 December 2011 (T Catry, I Catry) One first-winter (2CY) at La Cour, Aride on 4 January 2012 (T Catry, I Catry) This brings the number of Seychelles records to 44.








# Jacobin Cuckoo Clamator jacobinus

# **Great Spotted Cuckoo** *Clamator glandarius*



### Blue-cheeked Bee-eater Merops persicus




#### Mascarene Martin Phedina borbonica

# Sand Martin Riparia riparia

One flying over and roosting in settlement, Assumption on 4 January 2012 and probably the same individual 12 January 2012 (CJ Feare, J Linnebjerg, T Mahoune, I Labrosse, P Benoit). One at the back and northern end of the settlement, Assumption 31 January-4 February 2012 (CJ Feare, T Mahoune, I Labrosse, P Benoit).

One at the northern end of the settlement, Assumption 2 March 2012 (CJ Feare). This brings the number of Seychelles records to 25.

# Northern Wheatear Oenanthe oenanthe

One male at the Back Path, Picard, Aldabra on 21 December 2011 (M Šúr).


One adult male at the airstrip, Alphonse 20-27 January 2012 (A Duhec, R Jeanne).

One first-winter (2CY) male at end of Zone 3 turtle track count area, Picard, Aldabra on 1 March 2012 (S Denis, A Gouffe and C Onezia).

This brings the number of Seychelles records to 53.
