The following records have been accepted by Seychelles Bird Records Committee:

#### Herald Petrel Pterodroma heraldica


One dark morph at the hill, Cousin 10-11 June 2009 (DJR Andrews, J Love, M Hammers). This is the first record for Seychelles.

## Black-bellied Storm Petrel Fregetta tropica

One behind the IDC store, Alphonse Island found alive but later died 30 June 2010 (A Nahaboo, J Michel, C Freminot). This is the first record for Seychelles.


## Black-winged Pratincole Glareola nordmanni

One at open grass near the marina, Frégate 25-27 March 2010 (G Canning). This is the  $10^{th}$  record for Seychelles.




#### **Oriental Pratincole** *Glareola maldivarum*

Two at the airstrip, Praslin on 24 November 2008 (H Kisbye). This is the 15<sup>th</sup> record for Seychelles.



## Eurasian Hobby Falco subbuteo

One immature at the airstrip, Desroches 3-4 January 2010 (L Thompson, D Jupiter). This is the 25<sup>th</sup> record for Seychelles.



#### Reed Cormorant Phalacrocorax africanus

One adult at Cinq Cases, Grand Terre, Aldabra on 16 February 2010 (S Balderson) This is the 3<sup>rd</sup> record for Seychelles.


## **Glossy Ibis** *Plegadis falcinellus*

7-8 at La Passe harbour, La Digue on 23 March 2010 (I Rasmussen, R & M McGrath, F & H Cornelius)

Three including at least one adult breeding at grounds of Ephelia Resort, Port Launay, Mahé 25-26 March 2010 (I Rasmussen, R & M McGrath, F & H Cornelius) One at Plaisance, Mahe on 17 June 2010 (RM Mason)


One at Eden Island on 3 April, two on 19 April, four on 20 April three on 23 April and two on 22 June and subsequent dates until at least 6 November 2010, one remaining to 6 November 2010 (G Rocamora, A Solé, B Ochoa, H Leal, AP Skerrett, J Mortimer, R Syfret).

This raises the number of Seychelles records to 10.



#### Little Egret Egretta garzetta

One at the South Beach lagoon, Cousine 5 February-3 March 2010 (K Jolliffe, K Phillips, S-M Jolliffe). This is the 26<sup>th</sup> record for Seychelles.



## Lesser Kestrel Falco naumanni

One female at the IDC village, Desroches on 8 March 2010 (P Summerton). This is the  $6^{th}$  record for Seychelles.

#### Pratincole sp. *Glareola sp.*

One at lighthouse point, Desroches on 1 March 2010 (P Summerton). This is the 20<sup>th</sup> record for Seychelles in this category.

#### Sandwich Tern Sterna sandvicensis

One at the beach, Cousine 16 May 2010 (K Jolliffe, D Nell). This is the 5<sup>th</sup> record for Seychelles.

## Common Cuckoo Cuculus poliocephalus

One at Cousine 21 January-20 February 2010 (K Jolliffe, K Phillips, S-M Jolliffe). This is the 36<sup>th</sup> record for Seychelles.


## Lesser Cuckoo Cuculus poliocephalus

One at Seychelles Golf Course, Anse aux Pins, Mahé 13 January-27 February 2010, two present on the final date (E Palmer, AP Skerrett). This is the 15<sup>th</sup> record for

Seychelles.

## Common Swift Apus apus

One at Muraille Bon Dieu, Desroches on 5 February 2010, accepted with caveat (P Summerton). This is the 19<sup>th</sup> record for Seychelles.



## Little Swift Apus affinis


One at the east plateau, North Island on 24 January 2009 (M Mounac, A Saunders). This is the 5<sup>th</sup> record for Seychelles.

## European Roller Coracias garrulus

One at the IDC village, Desroches 7-19 February 2010 (P Summerton). Later dates to be added if applicable.

One adult at the airstrip, Alphonse 10-14 March 2010 (A Nahaboo, J Michel, PA Adam).

One at the airstrip, Bird Island on 18 March 2010 (G Rocamora). This brings the number of Seychelles records to 43.




## Ficedula sp.

One first winter Bird Island 13 November and 17 November 2009 (VE Phillips, NJ Phillips, R Bresson). This is the first record for Seychelles in this category.

#### Northern Wheatear Oenanthe oenanthe

One male at the old settlement, Denis on 3 January 2010 (M Sur). This is the 47<sup>th</sup> record for Seychelles.



#### Desert Wheatear Oenanthe deserti

One first-winter male race *oreophila* at the south beach, Cousine on 23-24 November 2009 (K Joliffe, S-M Joliffe). This is considered by SBRC to be probably the same the same bird observed on Bird Island 16-19 November 2009, the first record for Seychelles.
